## **\*\*Passage for the Month\*\***

**Beloved I Wish Above all Things that thou may Prosper and be in Health (3Jh. 1-2)**

The epistle of 3 John is addressed to a particular believer – Gaius rather than to a local congregation though it may have originally been intended for a larger audience.

The Elder wrote this letter to encourage Gaius to continue in the grace of hospitality to the believers. However, the lessons to be learnt from this prayer recorded in vs. 2 are profound.

First of all the word *wish* used in the KJV in the original Greek version is translated *pray*. And that is what God really wants for us not just wishes.

This prayer is in two folds; that “*thou mayest prosper and be in health*” and the second “*even as thy soul prospereth*”. This shows us that the prayer of prosperity and good health is connected with the condition of one’s soul. Notice that the prayer is not the other way round; for what shall a man gain in exchange of his soul? Absolutely nothing.

Resultantly, it is not wise to pray such a prayer for an unbeliever or one who has not Jesus or better still a purported believer who does not walk after the Spirit. Because that will be fatal as it will mean continuous decadence of the person’s soul even though on the outside it may appear he is prospering in every way.

The second lesson is that this prayer was prayed for Gaius because he was doing something worthy of the gospel that God wanted him to continue. And for that he needed indeed the resources (prosperity) and healthy body and mind. This reminds us of Ps. 41:1-3, which says the man who has regard for the weak or the poor including those in the family of believers will be sustained by God even on his sickbed and then restore him to health. God will also protect him from his enemies while He continues to bless him financially. Amazing, isn’t it?

Such blessing and more is ours when we make the business of God’s kingdom our priority and business. In particular helping those who carry the gospel and making their work easier in everyway possible. It is important for us to know that God does not go about throwing His blessings on anybody at all just because He is good. NO. Rather He gives it to those who are willing and ready to distribute to those who need them so that His love, goodness and the mercy will be shown to all mankind especially to those hurting and needs the blessing.

Please let’s not make any mistake about it. God wants us to prosper that is why His word encourages us to be diligent in His work. In fact Ps.35:27b say the Lord delights in the prosperity of His servants. What is more, 1 Cor. 9:10 says just for us to become RICH, Jesus became poor that we through His poverty might become rich.

Not just wealthy but rich!. For us to realize the above truth and have it manifested in our lives, we have to break the chains/mentality of poverty. Accept once and for all by faith that it is the WILL of God for us to Prosper and to be rich financially and healthy even as our souls prosper. And that poverty is a curse and the result of disobedience (Isa. 1:19-20) as well as laziness (Pro.20:13; 24:30-34)

Furthermore, we need to be willing to share in the joy of the prosperity of our brethren rather than being jealous and critical about them. That way, God can bless us too. Added to that is being good stewards of the “*little*” provision and resources God places in our hands.
